Arrival

Leaders & Network only have the option to arrive from 16:00 on Friday 5 July. You can start setting up your tents from 10:00 on Saturday 6 July. If you need to arrange to drop off equipment, or to start setting up tents earlier this can be arranged. Please email info@wellend.org.uk to arrange this.

Car parking at Well End is limited. Arrival slots from 12:30 will be allocated to groups closer to the event. We encourage participants to car pool to keep the number of cars down and help the flow of traffic.

Upon arrival, participants should make their way to the reception. Please note, dogs are not allowed on site at any time, except for guide/hearing dogs.

Departure

Departure on Sunday 7 July will be from 10:00. Departure slots will also be allocated to groups closer to the event to help with the flow of traffic.





Site Information About the site

Well End has 5 acres of meadows and 4 acres of woodland and has purpose built infrastructure to support numerous events throughout the year.

From the A1 Borehamwood junction (midway between Stirling Corner and the M25) take the A5135 towards Borehamwood.

As you pass the BP garage, bear right following the signs for Shenley, then immediately left as you pass the Elstree Tower, signs for Well End and Shenley. Go straight on at the small roundabout, and follow the road as it bears right then sharp left into Well End Road. Continue past Potters Lane and look for the entrance to the Centre on the Left after about 300m.

Toilets & Showers

Well End has plenty of toilet, shower and washing facilities including an accessible toilet available for those with additional needs.

Water

Drinking water is available from taps conveniently situated throughout the site.

Camping Areas

Groups will be pre-allocated camping areas corresponding to their numbers in camp. Should you have a particular preference please let the bookings team know in advance of the event and we will endeavour to allocate on a first come, first served basis.

Our Event Support team will ensure that fire breaks are left at regular intervals throughout the subcamp.

It is the group leader's responsibility to ensure that all Scout Association guidelines are adhered to within their own camping area.

Souvenirs

Our on-site shop will be open on Saturday 15:00-18:00, 19:30-late offering a range of drinks and snacks. A range of souvenirs are available to be purchased and pre-ordered from our online shop.

Waste & Recycling

Hertfordshire Scouts work with Cawleys for their waste disposal. As Cawleys sort the waste at their plant, there is no need to separate it before disposal in our bins.

The bins are situated at the entrance on the left hand side just in front of the Bungalow.

Internet

Well End has network dependent data coverage, which can vary through the site. There is no public wi-fi access, but we can make arrangements through the main office should it be required in an emergency.

Nights Away Permits

Every group will require a leader with a 'campsite' nights away permit.

Adult to Young Person Ratio

Adult to young person ratio should be adhered to as stated in POR.

Mobile Phone Charging

We have phone charging lockers available for adult participants to use free of charge, on a first come first served basis. Each locker has two sockets. Please provide your own mains charger.

You can register for a locker at reception. Please make sure you return the key - failure to do so will result in a ± 25 key replacement charge being made to your group.

Generators

Generators must NOT be switched on before 07:00 and should be switched off no later than 22:00.

Generators MUST be used in accordance with the manufacturer's guidelines. We strongly recommend that an earth rod is used in compliance with BS7671. Generator fuel MUST be stored in BS-approved safety containers. Generators should be diesel, unless no fueling required.

Event Safety Guidance

Well End has comprehensive safety procedures in place, details of these will be sent to you prior to the event. Please ensure that your group are made familiar with them.

Security

Well End is a fully enclosed site, entrances are barrier controlled and all key areas and access routes are covered by CCTV.

Access to the site will be restricted to event participants and Scout visitors only.

Post & Parcels

All post should be clearly marked with the intended recipients name and their Scout Group.

Should you wish any other 3rd party deliveries to be accepted by the site eg, Amazon Prime. Please ensure they are easily identifiable and that the delivery instructions are marked to reception. No delivery will be accepted before 09.00. Deliveries prior to arrival are by arrangement only.

Drones

Well End Activity Centre operates a strict no drones policy.

Fires & Cooking

It wouldn't be a camp without an evening spent round a campfire. Altar fires (1 per group) can be hired free. Please let us know by e-mail, info@wellend.org.uk, no later than one week before the event if required. It is highly unlikely there will be any available without pre-booking. No ground fires are permitted.

All cooking should be on gas. Please ensure that your gas pipes are in good condition and ideally have been replaced within the past 5 years. Gas bottles MUST be kept outside of the cooking tents on a suitable pipe.

First Aid

Each group will be responsible for providing first aid and dealing with medicines for its participants.

For prescribed medications that require refrigeration please ask at reception when on site.

With the ever increasing use of OSM and to simplify registration, we will not be gathering individual participants medical and contact information. If required we will contact group leaders using the contact information provided on the Guest Information Form which will be sent out prior to the event.

We will have a central first aid team to handle any incidents that occur outside of your camping area and to give advice/assistance to groups.

Smoking

We ask that anyone who wishes to smoke does so out of sight and away from young people. For more information see

Alcohol

No alcohol is permitted in the 'public' areas of Explorer Chill Fest. 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How To Find Us

Well End is based just passed Borehamwood and can be easily accessed by car.

From the A1 Borehamwood junction (midway between Stirling Corner and the M25) take the A5135 towards Borehamwood.

As you pass the BP garage, bear right following the signs for Shenley, then immediately left as you pass the Elstree Tower, signs for Well End and Shenley. Go straight on at the small roundabout, and follow the road as it bears right then sharp left into Well End Road. Continue past Potters Lane and look for the entrance to the Centre on the Left after about 300m.

On arrival please make your way to our Reception, which is situated centrally to the Activities Field and clearly signposted from the Car Park.
